Tendering an NSF chaque is considered non-payment of entry fees and may be subject to disciplinary action by the CKC. A \$25.00 service charge will be assessed to any NSF chaques or declined credit card transactions. Chaques post-dated after closing are not acceptable.

The Club will refund entry, service charge, and listing fee where a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Obedience Trial Secretary. A veterinarian's certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

PLEASE NOTE:

As of January 1, 1993 ALL ENTRIES must be on the official CKC Entry Form or a copy thereof. If you wish to submit entries on a computerized form it must be of the same size and format as the one issued by CKC and must bear the CKC Logo as per the enclosed entry forms. No exceptions will be made.

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entries will be acknowledged after closing date. Receipts, judging schedules and Exhibitors Passes will be mailed.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded after the closing date in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- (4.1.3, CKC Dog Show Rules) "A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out." "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" - CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
- All dogs and children must be kept under control at all times.
- Dogs must be exercised in designated areas only. Please pick-up after your dogs.
- All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- The conformation classes will be held outdoors rain or shine.
- The precincts of the show are defined as THE SHOULDICE ATHLETIC PARK.
- Camping and RV parking will be available on the Show Grounds.
- Additional entry forms may be photocopied.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.00 plus GST per copy.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC Registration Number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN Number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholders' name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number to you. Cost \$55.00 + GST (Canadian, \$58.30). ERN NUMBER MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE FIRST DAY OF HAVING ENTERED A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC

Contact Canadian Kennel Club, Show and Trials Division at FAX (416) 675-6506 or Phone (416) 675-5511. Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding & cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

Canada-USA Border Crossing: A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for

CLASSES OFFERED

Regular Official Conformation Classes (Dogs and Bitches Judged Separately)

Junior Puppy (6-9 Months); Senior Puppy (9-12 Months); 12-18 Month; Canadian Bred (Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country

are excluded); Bred by Exhibitor (The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards); Open; Veterans (at least seven years or older, may be spayed or neutered); Specials Only; Exhibition Only; Exhibition Only 3-6 Months: puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades.

Non-Regular Conformation Classes (All dogs must be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.)

Stud Dog and at least 2 of his get that are at least six months. Stud Dog & Get Brood Bitch & Progeny Brood Bitch and at least 2 of her get that are at least six months

Conformation Brace Two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). Must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

Conformation Team The requirements for this class are the same as those for the Brace Class except that 4 dogs shall be entered.

Parade of Veterans Open to all dogs of seven years of age or older

Unofficial Conformation Classes (All dogs must be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only.)

Parade of Title Holders Open to all dogs which have attained any CKC recognized title as confirmed by the CKC prior to closing date

For all dogs which have attained at least one leg on any CKC or AKC recognized hunting title or an ESSFTA Working Dog

(WD or WDX) title by the close of entries

Sweepstakes Classes (Dogs and Bitches Judged Separately)

Junior Puppy At least six months and under nine months. Puppy must be entered in an official class. Senior Puppy At least nine months and under twelve months. Puppy must be entered in an official class. 12-18 Month At least twelve months and under eighteen months. Puppy must be entered in an official class.

At least seven years and under nine years. Dog may be spayed or neutered and can be entered for 'Exhibition Only'. 7 to 9 Years of Age 9 to 12 Years of Age At least nine years and under twelve years. Dog may be spayed or neutered and can be entered for 'Exhibition Only'.

Over 12 Years of Age At least twelve years or older. Dog may be spayed or neutered and can be entered for 'Exhibition Only'.

Regular Obedience Classes

for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously Novice A

handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a

comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one Novice B dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog that has

earned the title of C.D., or a comparable title in any other country, but has not earned its title of C.D. in Canada, may only be entered in

Open A

for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any

person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More

than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may not be entered in both Open A and

> Open B at any one trial. A dog eligible for LID is also eligible for entry in this class at the same trial. Dogs which have attained a Canadian CDX title. Dogs which have attained a Canadian UD title are eligible to compete in this class. A

handler may handle more than one dog in this class, but must have a separate handler available for each dog for the group exercises.

Exhibition Only For all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

Transition Obedience Classes (N.B. Scores earned by dogs entered in Transition Classes are not eligible for High in Trial.)

For any purebred dog that has not earned the PCD or CD title. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person

may enter more than one dog in this class but must have an additional handler for each dog when judged together in Group Exercise.

Novice For any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD, CDX, or Utility or other advanced obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for Intermediate

entry in the Open A or B Class is also eligible for entry in the Novice C and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class

must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Brace Obedience Two dogs which have earned at least a Canadian CD title.

Team Obedience Four dogs which have earned at least a Canadian CD title

PLEASE NOTE: Dogs entered in non-regular or unofficial classes must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs must

check in prior to start of Class. Please ensure jump height is indicated on entry form for Open. Utility and Novice

Intermediate Obedience Classes

Sexually Altered Classes

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed & Unofficial Conformation Classes

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes (Two classes ONLY will be offered: Altered Male or Altered Female), the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Sex Altered in Breed.

Junior Handling (Conformation Only)

Time and Ring: TBA Cost \$2.00 Judge: David Swartwood

Handlers must show an English Springer Spaniel that is entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Junior Novice This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won

6 first places in the same class with competition. Junior Open:

This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year who have won 6 first places with competition. Once the handler has competed in the Junior Open Class, they may not compete in the Junior Novice

Class again.

Intermediate Novice: This class is for handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Junior Levels progress to this class.

Intermediate Open: This class is for handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough

experience to compete at this level

Senior Novice:

This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open: This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the

Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show

Section 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

a) registered with the CKC,

b) have an Event Registration Number,

c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d) if designated as a Miscellaneous Class breed, it must have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number.

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

a) it is not a designated Miscellaneous Class breed:

b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration:

c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.

d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the

first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitter entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or

b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.

c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least, one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be cancelled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
- be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number
- have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level

CAMPING FORM

All overnight parking and benching must be pre-paid by entry closing. Any overnight benching in the parking areas with/without a vehicle is subject to the below charges. Tents will not be allowed in the south end zone next to the ring area in the main field, for shade or otherwise. Note there is not a charge for x-pens and shade tents in the day benching area (north end of the field in tent city)

Rules For Parking

- Exhibitors must provide their own plywood to protect the grass from generator heat. There will not be any electrical hookups. Electricity is not available as it is hard to plug into a tree.
- Units parking in Preferred Parking must enter the enclosure prior to 12 midnight Thursday and MUST REMAIN UNTIL BEST IN SHOW IS COMPLETED MONDAY.
- Tow vehicles should be removed once the unit has been parked.
- There will be absolutely no dumping of gray water or sewage on the show grounds.

 Parking is a privilege extended by the Alberta Kennel Club. Any person(s) who feels that they cannot abide by the rules or resort to abusive language, argues with parking attendants or attempts to circumvent the rules will result in loss of parking privileges without refund. All parking is at your own risk.
- Vehicles parked in a "no parking" area will be towed at the owner's expense.
